In order to obtain reasonable assurance that candidates perform their academic work without unauthorised assistance of third parties, universities in Baden-Württemberg require an affidavit that confirms that the academic work was performed autonomously.

§161 of the German Criminal Code (StGB): Negligent False Oath, Negligent False Affirmation in Lieu of an Oath:

Para. 1: If any individual commits one of the acts indicated in §§ 154 to 156 out of negligence, then imprisonment for a period of no more than one year or a fine shall be imposed.

Para. 2: The perpetrator shall be exempt from punishment if he or she rectifies the false statement in a timely manner. The provisions of § 158 subsections (2) and (3) shall apply accordingly.
